

# The overpic environment with absolute positioning<sup>1</sup>

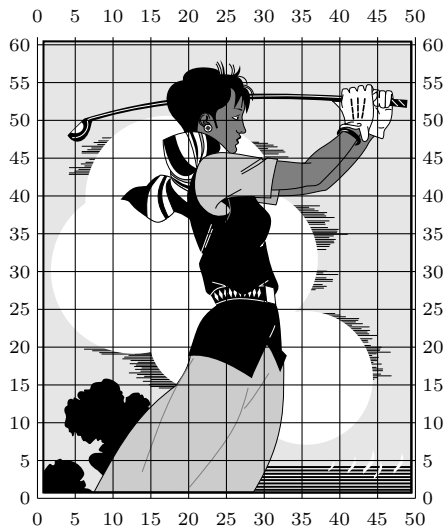


Insert before:

```
\usepackage[abs]{overpic}
...
\setlength\unitlength{1mm}
and/or local option unit=...
```

The original graphic from GHOSTSCRIPT:

```
\includegraphics[scale=.25]{golfer.ps}
```



A grid for orientation:

```
\begin{overpic}[scale=.25,grid,tics=5]%
  {golfer.ps}
\end{overpic}
```

(default for tics is 10)



Positioning the L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X output with \put commands:

```
\begin{overpic}[scale=.25,unit=1mm]%
  {golfer.ps}
  \put(3,28){\huge \LaTeX}
  \put(34,5){\includegraphics[scale=.07]%
    {golfer.ps}}
\end{overpic}
```

(default for unit is \unitlength)
